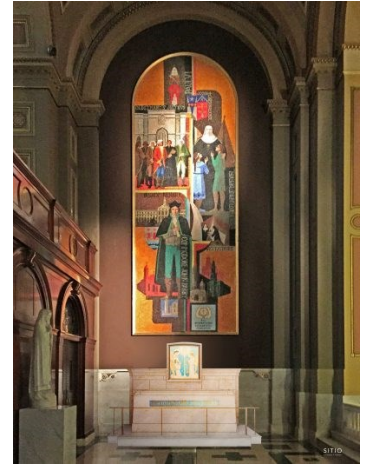


A CELEBRATION OF SAINT KATHARINE DREXEL'S LIFE

The sacred remains of Saint Katharine Drexel have now been transferred from the Motherhouse of the Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament in Bensalem, Pennsylvania, to the Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul in Philadelphia. The public celebration of the installation of her Tomb in the Cathedral Basilica will take place on Sunday, November 18, 2018 at the 11:00 AM Solemn Mass.
